The final programme will be influenced by the weather conditions of the day. The Event Management Committee may alter competition courses in order to address safety or to account for tidal, sea and beach condition changes. As far as possible we will undertake to provide all competitors with fair and equal conditions.

Event Clarifications:

- U10's will be eligible to compete in the Surf Race, only if they have obtained their 200m badge.
- U12 & U14 Members need to hold a current badge to compete in water events.
- U14 Board Rescue, Tube Rescue & Rescue Relays will be held as a three-round series.

Mixed Rescue Relay:

- Teams will comprise of 2 females and 2 males.
- The patient/rescuer gender combination is at the discretion of the team.
- The Tube rescue will be run as per the SLSNZ Surf Sport Competition Manual.
- The tube rescue team will finish by running up the beach and through the flagged gates, tagging the board rescue patient, who will be standing on the outside of the flagged gates on the beach side of the line.
- The board rescue race will be run as per the SLSNZ Surf Sport Competition Manual.

Event Entries:

- Entries close 9.00am **Thursday November 14**
- Search for "2019 Northern Region Junior Interclub #1 (Orewa)" on the SLSNZ online entry portal [here](#)
- Please ensure your Team Management & Surf Official information is up to date on the online system. Failure to list a team manager may mean that you will miss out on vital information.
- It is the expectation of the event organisers that clubs will only enter competitors that have the requisite ability to compete safely in any given event.
- By entering this event clubs & competitors agree to SLSNR using any images and video taken during the event for media and promotional purposes.

Entry Fees:

- **\$10.00** (inclu. GST) per Competitor
- Entries received after entry close will incur an additional **\$20.00 Late fee.**
- All entry fees will be calculated following the completion of the event and clubs will be invoiced directly.

Cancellation Policy:

- If the carnival is cancelled, with no postponement before the first event is conducted, 75% of all entry fees will be refunded to all Clubs (25% retained for administration costs).
- If a carnival is cancelled, after the first event is conducted no refund will be given.

Eligibility of Competitors:

- This competition is open to any current & active SLSNZ member, which requires:
 - A DOB recorded in the SLSNZ Database
 - A PRIMARY membership with the club they intend to participate for
 - A 200m safety badge to participate in identified events
- Competitors age group is determined by their age as at midnight on 30th September 2019.

Rules:

- The event will be conducted under the rules contained in the [SLSNZ Surf Sport Competition Manual](#), SLSNZ Code of Conduct, Sport Policies and any additional amendments as detailed on the website and any additional requirements as communicated by the Event Management Committee(s).

Competition Uniform:

- All competitors must wear their club cap.
- All competitors are to wear a High Visibility Vest
- All competitors will be issued with a competition number. These numbers will be emailed out to clubs and before the first race competitors will need to ensure their number is written on both arms. This will make marshalling and recording easier.

Surf Officials:

- All Clubs are required to provide at least 1 surf official for every 10 competitors (or part thereof).
- Please ensure that you have adequate numbers of Surf Officials available to meet the numbers of competitors entered.
- Clubs may be requested to provide more, should the need arise.
- Surf Officials need to wear their Blue Officials Shirt & should come prepared with their Surf Sports Competition Manual and a whistle.
- Any new Surf Officials please also remember to bring your Assessment Booklet.
- Surf Officials will also need to bring a water bottle. There will be containers for officials to refill drink bottles at each arena.

Water Safety Support:

- All Clubs are required to provide at least 1 qualified and refreshed Lifeguard for every 10 competitors (or part thereof) to act as water safety if required.
- Water safety support will be rostered to assist the Event Safety & Support team during water events.
- Clubs need to provide a list of names to the Event Manager by Thursday 14th November
- **All Water safety are required to turn up 'ready to respond'; equipped with Wetsuit, Lifeguard Rash Shirt, Fins, Tubes and Goggles.**
